

In response to the Madison County Board of Health Responsible Re-opening Plan

1. RBCC plans to re-open public services as soon as possible, allowing church leadership ample time to post signage, disinfect surfaces, place hand sanitizer stations, and inform our members on social distancing etiquette and procedures.
2. Separate entry and exit doors into the atrium have been established to allow necessary distancing. All doors, excluding exterior entry and restroom facilities will be kept open.
3. Children's Church Building will be off-limits until further notice. Sunday children's classes are suspended until further notice. Children are to remain with their parents while in the building.
4. A sanitizing team will be in place for pre and post service disinfecting.
5. Regular RBCC attendees will be notified concerning the need for face masks upon entry of the building until seated in the pew, and again as vacating the pew until exiting the building. Disposable masks will be available.
6. Pews will be cordoned-off to provide adequate social distancing between households.
7. Both Sunday and Wednesday services will be held in the main sanctuary.
8. Poured coffee will be provided.
9. Directional signage will be posted at entry & exit, and at restricted areas.
10. Informational signage will be posted in restrooms and at sanctuary entry/exit encouraging hand washing and social distancing.
11. Those feeling ill, having a fever, or exhibiting cold & flu symptoms, or having been knowingly exposed to COVID-19 will be encouraged to participate via the RBCC live-stream.
12. Notices will be sent to regular RBCC attendees concerning these changes and encouraging masking, social distancing, and regard for others' well-being amid this pandemic. We ask that anyone attending our services alert an elder to any known COVID 19 exposure. Should we be notified of exposure to the virus the church will contact every household in attendance. Sanitizing routine will be followed.
